The visiting umpires do not have to pay for their hospitality, meals, internal transportation and their fees will be canceled according to the ITTF International Regulations.

5 – RULES

The XX Major Latin American Championship will develop according to the current laws and regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) and the LATTU dispositions.

Verifications will be carried out during the competitions to detect the use of prohibited solvents on the player's rackets, using the ENEZ dispositive, as well as the thickness of the cover and the surface regularity, according to the current ITTF regulations for international events.

7 – ELIGIBILITY

In this Championship will only participate the players nominated by their Federations or National Associations that are current on their Latin American Union affiliation payments (including previous years) (\$ 100.00 annual US Dollars) and ITTF (\$ 150.00 annual US Dollars), including the year 2010.

The countries that do not fulfill with the previous requirement could not participate in this event. Will not exist special concessions.

8 – REGISTRATION'S PRESENTATIONS

The deadline for the definitive Nominal Registrations will be Monday, February 15, 2010. No registration will be accepted after that date.

The registrations should be presented with the players names for the events by TEAMS, SINGLES, DOUBLES, MIXED and SINGLES SUB-21.

See annexed Official Registration Form.

It will be a essential requirement to present the passport of each participant player which will be photocopied as an eligibility writing evidence and at the same time will serve as a Data Base for the ITTF – LATTU Ranking.

9 – THE JURY

It will be formed by 3 Delegates of the participant countries, a LATTU Executive Committee Member, the LATTU Technical Director and the Event's Referee.

The Jury meeting will be on February 28 at 19:00 hours where all documents of each country will be reviewed and on second occasions during the Championship if it is necessary.

The Association that from a direct way is affected by a matter decided on a Jury meeting will be authorized to have a representative in such meeting.

10 – REFEREES AND UMPIRES

The competences will be directed by a Referee assigned by LATTU, Mr. Fernando Aguilar and Qualified LATTU – ITTF personnel.

The invited Umpires from other countries should be categorized as ITTF – LATTU Umpires, pointing out on its registration its number of international identification.

11 – PRIZES

It will be rewarded with Medals the winner of the first 4th first places of each event.

It will be awarded with Special Trophies the countries occupant the First Places of the Event of Men and Women Teams from the Latin American Championship.

The trophy for the country that results an Absolute Champion will be given to the country with the highest general punctuation of the Championship.

12 – HOSPITALITY

The hospitality will be given in the Hotel Radisson Cancun, located in Ave. Chichen Itza with Ave. Nader Cancun, 20 minutes from the competence site.

The cost for the persons contemplated within the Official Delegation will be of US \$ 40.00 per day and will include hospitality, three daily meals, transport airport/hotel/airport and transportation to the competences gymnasium.

All persons that attend outside the official Delegation from each country should cancel to the Organizing Committee the amount of \$ 60.00 US D daily if they wish to lodge in the Official Hotel.

The delegations will be received starting from 14:00 hours on February 28, 2010, until breakfast on March 7, 2010.

13 – MEDICAL INFORMATION

Antidoping Control.

The analysis of antidoping control will be carried out along the competence according to the norms established by the Medical Commission of the FEMETEME Organizing Committees and the ITTF Regulations.

Medical Controls and Medical Exams.

Each player that refuses to submit to a medical exam or that is found guilty of doping will be taken from them the Accreditation and will be expelled from the Major Latin American Championship and also expelled from future international competitions according to the established sanctions by LATTU and ITTF.

14 – COMPETITION SYSTEM

TEAM EVENTS

It will be played according to the established format for the competitions of Olympic Games.

- Four (4) individuals matches, and (1) double.

- Each player can only two matches.
- Matches Format :
 1. A vs. X
 2. B vs Y
 3. Double matches: (C/A or C/B) vs (Z/X or Z/Y)
 4. (B or A) vs. Z
 5. C vs (Y or X)

All matches in the Team events will be to the best of 5 games. It will be formed as many groups as are necessary with a minimum of three (3) Teams by group and a maximum of four (4) teams, classifying to a final phase the best 2 of each group.

The final phase will be carried out by the system of "Simple Eliminary".

The draw will be carried out according to the ITTF World Ranking up to the month of February 2010, using the "Serpent System".

The ranking of each team will be the sum of the singles ranking of the best 3 players register placed in the ITTF – LATTU Ranking.

MIXED AND DOUBLES EVENTS

It will be played by the System of "Simple Eliminary" and the matches will be the best of 5 games. A prize will be given to the two third places.

It will not be allowed to form couples from different Associations.

The draws will be carried out according to the ITTF – LATTU World Ranking to the month of February 2010.

SINGLE EVENTS CLASSIFICATORY TO THE WORLD CUPS 2010.

The 8 best players from the ITTF – LATTU Ranking, will be directly classified to the final key of 32 players.

If there were more registrations than the remaining available fields in the final key, a classificatory phase will be played, forming groups of 3 and up to 4 players per group, classifying the 2 first places of each group. The matches will be played to the best of 5 games. In the final phase will play to the simple eliminary to the best of 7 sets.

A prize will be given to the two third places.

It will be played in a single key of "Simple Eliminary", all the matches will be to the best of 5 games and the draw will be carried out according to the ITTF – LATTU Ranking to the month of February 2010.

15 – REGISTRATION COST BY EVENT

According to the Agreements taken by the LATTU General Assembly celebrated in Guarulhos, Brazil, in March 2007, starting 2008, there should be pay in the Major Latin American events, the following registration costs:

- * Doubles US \$ 15.00 / Couples
- * Mixed Doubles US \$ 15.00 / Couples
- * Singles US \$ 15.00 / Player
- * Singles Sub.21 US \$ 10.00 / Player
