Argentine Table Tennis Federation and Latin American Table Tennis Union summon all member countries to join in the XV Cadet Latin American Championship (U-15) and XVI Junior Latin American Championship (U-18), to be held on June 16-20 in Buenos Aires, Argentina.

### **1 - Organizer**

XV Cadet Latin American Championship and XVI Junior Latin American Championship, to be held in Buenos Aires city, will be organized by the Argentine Table Tennis Federation jointly with Latin American Table Tennis Union.

### **2 – Date and place**

Events previously mentioned will develop at CeNARD Sports Center (located in Crisólogo Larralde St. 1050, Ciudad Autónoma de Buenos Aires), with eight (8) competition tables on June 16-20.

### **3 – Categories**

Categories to be played are Cadet (U-15) and Junior (U-18). The following athletes will be able to take part in each Category:

Junior: Players born in or after January 1, 1992

Cadet: Players born in or after January 1, 1995

### **Cadet Singles Event**

It will select the best 8 male and female players that will have right to take part in the qualifying round to integrate the Latin American Teams for the World Cadet Challenge, to be carried out in the city of Hyderabad, India 2010.

Each country will only be represented by a masculine player and the feminine one both in the Latin-American Qualifying round and in the World Challenge 2010. This qualifying round will be held in Guayaquil, Ecuador, during ITTF Junior Circuit 2010.

XV Junior Latin American Championship will award qualification for 9<sup>o</sup> Junior World Championships, to be celebrated in Bratislava, Slovakia, on December 4-11. Twenty boy's teams and twenty girl's teams will participate in the event, representing the 6 Continental ITTF Areas.

Latin America will be represented by the first two (2) places of the Team Event in both sexes. A third team of the Pan-American area will be designed by ITTF, according to World Team Ranking in October 2010.

Teams and players qualified will have to confirm to LATTU Presidency their participation or declination to the following addresses.

**Net Supports:** Donic

**Dividers:** Argentine Brand

**Type of Apartment:** Parquet/wood

There will be six (6) extra tables for warming up next to Competition Room.

### **9 – Eligibility**

The Championships will be carried out only for qualified players for every Region and invited by LATTU and nominated by their Federations or National Associations.

(Attached document with the countries and players Invited)

All the countries and players taking part will have to be updated on their payments of annual membership (**including previous years**) before the Championship (\$ 100.00 dollars per year for Latin-American Union and \$150.00 dollars per year for ITTF) including the year 2010.

This requirement will be absolutely indispensable for countries to be able to take part in these events.

### **10 – Presentation of Registrations**

The inscriptions will have to be sent according to the names and dates of birth of the players in all the events to the Organizing Committee of XV Cadet Latin-American Championship 2010 and XVI Junior Latin-American Championship 2010.

It will be an obligation of the Delegates to deliver a photocopy of the passport information for every player.

The drawings will be carried out according to ITTF-LATTU world ranking most updated to the date (June 01, 2010) and according to what ITTF establishes for Cadet and junior events.

### **12 – Jury**

It will be integrated by three (3) delegates of the countries taking part, a member of the LATTU Executive Board, LATTU Technical Director and the Referee of the Event. The meeting of the Jury will be on June 15 at 19 hours, where the papers of every country will be checked (they can be checked again during the Championship if necessary). Association that in a direct way is affected by a matter decided in a meeting of the Jury will be authorized to have a representative person in the above mentioned meeting.

### **13 – Referee and Umpires**

The Championships will be judged by a Referee designed by LATTU, ITTF qualified and a ITTF qualified Auxiliary Judge, approved previously by LATTU. The invited International Umpires will have the Referee Categories ITTF or LATTU Categories, previously approved for the LATTU Rules Director.

### **14 – Awards**

The first four (4) positions for category and sex will get Trophies and Medals. In doubles and singles event of every category and sex the first three (3) positions will be rewarded with Medals, granting him two third places in every case. All the players will receive a Participation Certificates.

### **15 – Cost of the registrations for events**

- Teams U\$S 20.00
- Doubles U\$S 10.00
- Mixed Doubles U\$S 10.00
- Singles U\$S 10.00

### **16 - Hospitality:**

The hospitality will cost U\$S 30 dollars daily for person and it will include the internal transportation, accommodation and three (3) daily meals, in the

### **Terrestrial transport**

- Airport city of Buenos Aires – Hotel
- Terrestrial terminal Buenos Aires – Hotel
- Internal transport of the competition

### **Air transport**

The delegations of Latin America must arrive at the International Airport of the City of Buenos Aires (Ezeiza)

### **Accommodation**

- Delegations will be lodged at the CeNARD sports centre hotel.
- Competition Center is located to scarce meters of the hotel, inside CeNARD Center.
- The accompanies persons not included in the delegation will be able to be lodged in a three stars hotels for U\$S 60 dollars per day (double room) or U\$S 100 (single room).
- The Temperature Ambience of the City of Buenos Aires will be between 5 °C and 15 °C Centigrade grades.

### **17 – Registration**

The delegations will be formed as maximum as follows:

According to the teams and players classified by every country, a classified ceam will have right to take part with 4 Players, a coach and a delegate.

In the case of players invited by every region or by “LATTU Wild Card”, a coach or A delegate will have right to go.

Every country will have the right one (1) ITTF Umpire, any time it is previously notified to the Organizing Committee. The Umpire visitor will be free of the payment of Hospitality, Feeding and Internal Transport and will be payed according to the ITTF International Regulations.

### **18 – Host country**

The host country will be able to duplicate his players' payroll in Teams, Doubles and Mixed Doubles in the Cadet Event. Singles, Doubles and Mixed doubles will be able to duplicate in Junior Event.

They will be able only get points (for final punctuation for countries) the best positioned ones. The best position Team, the two (2) best couples of Boys' and

Girls' doubles and the first four (4) couples of Mixed Doubles in the Cadet Category, while in the Junior Category they will be able to get points the first two (2) couples of Girls' and Boys' doubles, the first four (4) couples of Mixed Doubles and the four (4) best positioned in the events of Boys' and Girls' singles.

### **Note:**

A country will be able to register one or more Cadet Players in any Junior Event, any time it does not exceed the number of four (4) players register in the Junior Category.

No Cadet Player will be able to take part in the same event in both categories.

### **18 – Competition system for both categories**

#### **Team's event**

It will be played according to the Modified Swaytling System (A-X, B-Y, C-Z, A-Y, B-X) to the best of 5 matches in both categories and sexes, every match will be played to the best of 5 games.

12 teams are summoned in every Category and sex. 4 groups of 3 teams will be conformed, qualifying the first two (2) places of every group to a final stage that will be disputed by the simple playoff system. In Junior event, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place will be disputed.

If at the moment of Technical Meeting the countries participation (12 teams nominated according to regional Qualifying rounds and "Wild Card ULTM") is not confirmed, 3 groups will be conformed, qualifying the first two (2) places to the final stage of "Simple Elimination", qualifying straight to position 1 the first place of group 1 and in the position 8 the first place of group 2. Positions 4 and 5 will be drawn for the First and Second Place of group 3.

#### **Teams Drawing**

The Drawing will be carried out by snake system, according to the ITTF-LATTU Ranking most updated to the date, joining the rating points of the first three (3) present players of every country in the event.

No ranked teams will be drawn in an equitable way trying not to place together any more than two countries of the same region in the same group.

#### **Doubles and mixed doubles event**

It will be played by the system of "Simple Playoffs" and the matches will be to the best of 5 games. Two third places will be rewarded.

### **Singles events**

Groups of 3 or 4 players will be conformed in the first qualifying stage, classifying the 2 first ones for every group. The matches will be played to the best of 5 games.

Players qualified in the first stage will compete by the system of “Simple Playoffs”, and the matches of this stage will be to the best of 7 games. Two Third places will be rewarded.

The drawings of the individual events will be done according to the ITTF-LATTU Ranking most updated to the date.

In case of unrated players, the Referee and LATTU will determine the way as equitable as possible the drawing, of these players always using the ITTF criteria for WJC Events.

### **19 – The country accumulating the most points**

The country of the Championships accumulating most points will be defined by the sum of the following punctuation in both Categories:
