IV LATIN AMERICAN VETERANS CHAMPIONSHIP NOVEMBER 12 – 15, SAN SALVADOR, ESA 2009



SUMMON

The Salvadorean Table Tennis Federation (FESALTEME) and the Latin American Table Tennis Union (LATTU), summons all member countries to participate the **IV LATIN AMERICAN VETERANS CHAMPIONSHIP**, to take place from November 12 to November 15, 2009 in San Salvador, El Salvador.

1. ORGANIZER.

The **IV Latin American Veterans Championship** to take place in San Salvador, El Salvador, will be organized by the **Salvadorean Table Tennis Federation (FESALTEME)** in coordination with the **Latin American Table Tennis Union (LATTU)**.

2. PLACE AND DATE.

The championship will take place from Thursday, November 12 to Sunday, November 15, 2009, in the Central Venues of the Sport Palace “**Carlos El Famoso Hernández**”, in the city of San Salvador, ESA, where 16 competence tables would be set up.

3. CATEGORIES.

They will compete in Men is as well as in Women's in the categories included between the following birthdays :

- 35 – 39 Years Category (1974 – 1970)
- 40 – 49 Years Category (1969 – 1960)
- 50 – 59 Years Category (1959 – 1950)
- 60 – 64 Years Category (1949 – 1945)
- 65 – 69 Years Category (1944 – 1940)
- 70 – or more years Category (Born before or in the 1939)

4. EVENTS.

There will play the following events :



- 1.- Men's and Women's Teams in all Categories.
- 2.- Men's and Women's Doubles in all Categories.
- 3.- Men's and Women's Singles in all Categories.

Note :

For the Team's event, if in any category or sex are not registered four (4) or more Teams the Organizing Committee declares such categories deserted and the Teams will form part of the inferior immediate category always and when it does not surpasses the established number per players established in the current basis.

In the doubles and singles events should be registered more than four (4) players or couples to be able to play Category, on the contrary they would move to the immediate inferior Category as long as when in the doubles case will not exceed the amount of couples allowed per country.

6. REGULATIONS.

The **Latin American Veterans Championship** will develop according to the current Table Tennis and regulations for International Competences issued by the **International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF)**.

7. EQUIPMENT.

The following equipment will be used :

- * 16 Tables – STAG 1000 Dx.
- * Balls *** stars brand – STAG, orange color.
- * Supports w/net – STAG.
- * Surrounds – STAG.
- * Kind of Floor – Synthetic.

There will also be 12 warming tables next to the Competence Hall.

8. ELLEGIBILITY.

The Championships will be carried out only for the players nominated by their Federations or National Associations and that in addition be up dated on their affiliations (including previous years) before the Championship with regard to their payments to the Latin American Union (\$ 100.00 Dollars annually) and to the ITTF (\$ 150.00 Dollars annually) including the year 2009.

9. REGISTRATION'S PRESENTATIONS.

The registration's should be send with the players names and dates of birthdays and by order of force in each Category and Events to the Organizing Committee of the **IV Latin American Veterans Championships 2009**.

Each Association should confirm to the Organizing Committee on October 12, 2009, 30 days before the Championship, its numerical participation and no later than October 21, 2009, 20 days before the beginning of the event, should send their registration of the people who make up the Delegation.



The registrations should be send on the established format specifying the lodging option they will use.

10. THE DRAW.

The draws will take place according to the force order that the countries register their players in each Category, try to separate as much as possible the players from a same country and taking into account the results of the previous edition in Venezuela 2007. The Referee will make the draw before the event and will only present to the Technical Congress the four draws to correct possible mistakes in the draw.

11. THE JURY.

It will be formed by three (3) Delegates from the participant countries, a member of LATTU'S Executive Committee, LATTU'S Technical Director and the Event's General Referee.

The Jury Meeting will be on November 11 at 19:00 hours where each country's documentation will be reviewed at time during the Championship if necessary. It will be asked a passport photocopy to each participant player. The Association that on a direct manner is affected by a matter that be decided on a Jury Meeting will be authorized to have a representant in such meeting.

12. REFEREE AND UMPIRES.

The Championships will be judged by an ITTF qualified Referee and one qualified Assistant umpire ITTF or LATTU, assigned by LATTU.

The invited International Umpires should have to own the ITFF or LATTU Umpires Categories and be approved by LATTU'S Umpire's Direction.

The National Umpires should have as a minimum qualification the Category of Umpire Level II LATTU.

13. AWARDS.

There will be given trophies and medals to the winning teams of the first places by Category and gender, as well as medals to the winners of the second and third places (there will be rewarded two third places) on the Doubles and Singles events from each Category and gender there will be awards for the three (3) first places with Medals, giving two (2) third places in each case. All players will receive a Participation Certificate. A Special Trophy will be given to the Championship absolute winner country.

14. HOSPITALITY.

The arrival date will be November 11 and the departure date November 16, 2009.

15. REGISTRATIONS.

The delegations will be formed as maximum in the following way :

The countries could freely register their players for the Men and Women Singles events.

The countries could only present One (1) Team by Category and gender, formed by Two (2) players and Four (4) Double couples by Category and gender.

* One (1) Delegate.

* One (1) Umpire ITTF or LATTU Level.

To the visiting umpire will be pay their fees according to what is specify by the Organizing Committee for the event.

The host country could present two (2) Teams by Category and could double its couples of Men's Doubles and Women's Doubles by Category.

16. REGISTRATION COST BY EVENTS.

Based on Agreements taken by the LATTU'S General Assembly celebrated in Guarulhos, Brazil, in March 2007, starting the year 2008 should be payed in the Majors Latin American events, the following registration costs :

- * Teams----- US 15.00/Team
- * Doubles----- US 10.00/Couples
- * Singles-----US 15.00/Player

17. COMPETENCES SYSTEM

TEAM'S EVENT

* It will be played in two phases. The first phase in groups of 3 or 4 teams each one.

* Two teams of each group will more to the final phase.

The final phase will be played by the system of “**Simple Eliminary**”.

The playing system will be the Courbillon Cup (A vs X, B vs Y, double, A vs Y, B vs X).

All the games will play the best of 5 games.

One Team will be formed by 2 players.

DOUBLES EVENTS

A Single Eliminary will be played and the teams will be to the best of 5 games. A prize will be given to the two third Places.



SINGLES EVENTS

It will be formed as many groups as be necessary in the First Eliminary Phase Classifying the 2 first ones for each group. The games will be played to the best of 5 games.

The final will be played with the qualified of the eliminary phase that should compete by the system of “**Simple Eliminary**” and the games in this phase will be to the best of 5 games.

A prize will be given to the two, third places.
